Social media users saw PTI leader Bir Sturgohar post a video statement. He stated that Tehreek-e-Insaf had an advantage in more than 150 seats while doing this.

Barrister Gauhar stated that based on information obtained from the polling place, there is a 150-vote advantage. While election results are typically declared by 12 o'clock, the Election Act requires results to be declared by 2 o'clock.

He remarked that we have not received the results, may peace be upon the supporter, and that they should stay in the RO office till form 47 is completed, at which point they will establish the next KPK and federation government.

It should be mentioned that millions of people used their right to vote on Thursday, when the general election polls were open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Qaisara Elahi, an independent candidate, is ahead with 11856 votes, while QL Chaudhry Salik Hussain is trailing with 2699 votes in the inconclusive result of the 22 polling stations in NA 64 Gujarat.

Karachi, NA 248

Following an inconclusive count at a polling location in National Assembly Constituency NA 248 Karachi, Babar Khan of Jamaat-e-Islami and Khalid Maqbool Siddiqui of MQM-Pakistan both had 637 and 79 votes, respectively.

Karachi NA 234

A polling place in NA 234 Karachi yielded an inconclusive result; independent candidate Faheem Khan received 135 votes, while Moin Pirzada of MQM Pakistan received 96 votes.
Karachi NA 246

After two NA 246 Karachi polling places yielded inconclusive results, Aminul Haq of MQM Pakistan led with 330 votes, while Hafiz Naeemur Rehman of Jamaat-e-Islami came in second with 235 votes.

Multan NA 149

After ten NA 149 Multan voting places yielded inconclusive results, independent candidate Aamir Dogar led with 3097 votes, while IPP candidate Jahangir Khan Tareen trailed with 1784 votes.

Complete NA 55 Rawalpindi Result

Abrar Ahmed of the PML-N won NA-55 Rawalpindi with 78542 votes, while Raja Basharat, an independent, received 67101 votes.

NA 151 Multan

Inconclusive result of NA-151 Multan's 49 polling stations, Independent candidate Mehrabano Qureshi is leading with 17592 votes while Muslim League (N)'s Abdul Ghaffar Dogar is behind with 12879 votes.

NA 216 Matiari

Bashir Memon of Muslim League (N) is ahead with 2863 votes and Makhdoom Jameel-uz-Zaman of PPP is behind with 2697 votes.

NA 150 Multan

Inconclusive result of 3 polling stations of NA 150 Multan, independent candidate Zain Qureshi is leading with 656 votes while Muslim League (N)'s Javed Akhtar is behind with 652 votes.

Multan NA 148

Yusuf Raza Gilani of the PPP leads with 3412 votes, while Taimur Malik of the Independent Party leads with 2954 votes in the inconclusive results of the 20 voting stations in NA 148 Multan. With 2236 votes, Ahmad Hussain of the Muslim League (N) is far behind.

Faisalabad, NA 100

Following an inconclusive count across 77 NA 100 Faisalabad voting stations, independent candidate Nisar Jat leads with 29759 votes, while Muslim League (N) candidate Ranathnaullah trails with 21067 votes.

PS10 Larkana

The Sindh Assembly Constituency PS10 Larkana polling station yielded an inconclusive result. Faryal Talpur of the PPP received 897 votes, while Kifaitullah of the JUI received 230 votes.

NA253 Harnai

NA 253 Harnai, Sibi K 5 polling station inconclusive result, independent candidate Saddam ahead with 617 votes while Pakhtunkhwa MEP's Habib-ur-Rehman trailed behind with 382 votes.

NA 266 Fort Abdullah

Inconclusive result of NA 266 Qila Abdullah and 11 polling stations of Chaman, Pashtun Khwaja Milli Awami Party Chairman Mehmood Khan Achakzai is leading with 6590 votes while Maulana Salahuddin Ayubi of JUI(F) is behind with 4870 votes.

NA 185 DG Khan

Inconclusive result of 42 polling stations of NA-185 DG Khan, Independent candidate Zartaj Gul is ahead with 16418 votes and Usman Farooqui of Jamaat-e-Islami is behind with 15120 votes. Muhammad Khosa of PPP is on the third position with 231 votes.

NA 18 Haripur

Inconclusive result of 40 polling stations of NA-18 Haripur, Independent candidate Umar Ayub is ahead with 15350 votes while Babar Nawaz of Muslim League (N) is behind with 8136 votes.

Harnai NA253

Independent candidate Saddam led with 617 votes at NA 253 Harnai, Sibi K 5 voting station, with an indecisive result; Pakhtunkhwa MEP Habib-ur-Rehman came in last with 382 votes.

Fort Abdullah, NA 266

Pashtun Khwaja Milli Awami Party Chairman Mehmood Khan Achakzai is ahead with 6590 votes, while Maulana Salahuddin Ayubi of JUI(F) is trailing with 4870 votes. The results of NA 266 Qila Abdullah and 11 polling stations in Chaman are inconclusive.

DG Khan, NA 185

With 42 polling places in NA-185 DG Khan yielding an inconclusive result, independent candidate Zartaj Gul leads with 16418 votes, while Jamaat-e-Islami's Usman Farooqui behind with 15120 votes. With 231 votes, PPP's Muhammad Khosa is in third place.

Tonic PK 108

KP Assembly Constituency PK 108 Tank has ten polling places. The results are inconclusive; independent candidate Usman Bettani is ahead with 2180 votes, while JUI(F) candidate Mahmood Bettani is trailing with 939 votes.

Nowshera, NA33

With 15425 votes, independent candidate Shahid Ahad Khattak leads NA-33 Nowshera based on partial results from 62 voting places. Khan Parvez of the Awami National Party is trailing with 3940 votes, while Parvezakhtak of the PTIP is in third place with 3669 votes.

NA50 Attock

After 13 polling places in NA50 Attock, the results are still unclear. With 5176 votes, TLP's Hafiz Mohammad Saad leads, while Independent candidate Iman Waseem trails with 2838.

Faisalabad, NA 96

Results from 24 voting places in NA 96 Faisalabad are inconclusive. With 10248 votes, independent candidate Rai Haider is ahead, while Muslim League (N) candidate Nawab Shirosir is trailing with 5992 votes.

NA 52 Rawalpindi

After 53 polling places in NA-52 Rawalpindi produced an inconclusive result. Raja Pervez Ashraf of the PPP is leading with 11605 votes, followed by independent Tariq Aziz Bhatti with 9543 and Javed Akhlaq of the PML-N with 7837.

Sahiwal, NA 143

Amidst 224 polling sites in NA 143 Sahiwal, the results are inconclusive. With 73489 votes, independent candidate Hasan Nawaz Khan leads, while independent candidate Tufail Jat trails with 65438 votes. IPP's Noman Langriyal, with 24322 votes, is in third place.

NA 6 Lowrider One

After 25 polling places in NA-6 Lowerdir One produced an inconclusive result, Muhammad Shabbir Khan, an independent, is ahead with 3186 votes, while Sirajul Haque of Jamaat-e-Islami is trailing with 2053 votes.

North Waziristan, NA 40

Following 21 polling places in NA-40 North Waziristan, the results are inconclusive. With 3617 votes, independent candidate Malik Aurangzeb leads, while Mohsin Dawar of the National Democratic Movement trails with 3104 votes.

Sukkur 2, NA 201

After two polling places in NA 201 Sukkur 2 of the National Assembly, the results are inconclusive. Syed Khurshid Shah of the PPP has received 1930 votes, while Muhammad Saleh of the JUI has received 460 votes.

Jacobabad, NA 190

In the National Assembly Constituency NA 190 Jacobabad, where there was an inconclusive polling station, Muhammad Mian Soomro, an independent, received 504 votes, while PPP candidate Ejaz Jakhrani received 8 votes.

PS 01: JACOBABAD ONE

Unofficial results from PS 01 Jacobabad One of the Sindh Assembly show that independent candidate Abdul Razzaq Khoso is in second place with 30 votes, and Sher Muhammad Mughiri of the Pakistan Peoples Party is leading with 518.

PS 02 JACOBABAD TOW

According to the unofficial results from PS 02 Jacobabad 2 of the Sindh Assembly, Dr. Sohrab Sarki of the PPP is in second place with 55 votes, and Shafiq Khoso of the JUI is in first place with 560 votes.

PS 03 Jacobabad 3

The unofficial results from PS 03 Jacobabad 3 voting station in Sindh Assembly show that Mumtaz Jakharoni, an independent, has 318 votes, while Aurangzeb Panhor, a member of the Pakistan Peoples Party, is in second place with 17 votes.

The nationwide election polling period has concluded.

All around the nation, the General Election 2024 polls were open until five o'clock in the evening.

A number of independent candidates, the Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz, the Pakistan People's Party (PPP), the Muttahida Qaumi Movement-Pakistan, Jamaat-e-Islami (JI), Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam Fazl (JUI-F), Tehreek-e-Labaik Pakistan, and others were competing for 265 National Assembly seats and 599 provincial assembly seats.

There are seventeen thousand eight hundred and sixteen candidates running for the first time in the nation, and twelve crore eighty five lakh eighty five thousand seven hundred and sixty voters have registered to vote.

Voting required the original identity card to be presented; votes on expired identity cards were also accepted; ballots for the National Assembly were printed on green paper, while those for the provincial assembly were printed on white paper. Additionally, polling places were closed to the use of handbags, cell phones, and cameras.
